Obtaining the Energy Factor (E.F.) of Your New Water Heater

Note: some water heater manufacturers make this easier than others.

- Inspect your water heater and the printed materials that came with it, look for EF or E.F. Rating.
- Ask your water heater supplier to provide you with the Energy Factor rating.
- If you purchased a G.E. water heater from Home Depot, G.E. water heater information sheets, complete with EF ratings, are often available at the store's water heater display area.
- Go to www.clallampud.net/conservation: click on the Water Heater E.F. Ratings link. Provide the information requested. This will generate a listing of one or more water heaters with model numbers similar to what you entered. When you find a match, note the Energy Factor. If it meets or exceeds the above requirements, your water heater should be eligible for the rebate.

Note: water heaters less than 50 gallons and on-demand/tankless water heaters are ineligible for this rebate.

Verifying ENERGY STAR® Certification of CFL Light Fixtures:

ENERGY STAR CFL Fixture Rebates require current ENERGY STAR® certification demonstrated by listing(s) on the official ENERGY STAR® website (www.energystar.gov). The PUD offers the following ENERGY STAR® verification methods to help you ensure that your CFL fixture(s) is/are rebate eligible.

Please note:

- 1) New models for 2010/late 2009 may take several months to appear on the official ENERGY STAR® CFL fixture list on www.energystar.gov. Requests received for unlisted CFL fixtures will be returned.
- 2) Asterisks* on ENERGY STAR lists are "wild cards"; they mean, insert any letter or number here.

Certification Verification:

- 1) Visit the PUD's Conservation Department web page at www.clallampud.net/conservation
 - a. Select the ENERGY STAR CFL Fixtures List link to obtain a list of CFL fixtures by manufacturer. Note this is a very large PDF file, usually 6 MB or more in size.
 - b. Once you've found your fixture's listing, print that page and attach it to your rebate form.
- 2) Visit the source of the above CFL Fixtures List: www.energystar.gov
 - a. Under the Find ENERGY STAR Products section, select Light Fixtures.
 - b. On the Light Fixtures web page, download the Qualified Light Fixtures Product List. Note this is a very large PDF file, usually 6 MB or more in size.
 1. Once you've found your fixture's listing, print that page and attach it to your rebate form.
