



INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received by Public Utility District (PUD) No. 1 of Clallam County (District) until 2:30 p.m. Pacific Time Wednesday, July 6, 2022. Bids may be submitted via mail addressed to PUD No. 1 of Clallam County, Attn: Contracts Coordinator, P.O. Box 1000, Carlsborg, Washington 98324 or via express delivery addressed to PUD No. 1 of Clallam County, Attn: Contracts Coordinator, 100 Hooker Road, Sequim, WA 98382. If mailed, the bid must be in a sealed bid envelope with the name and address of the Bidder and bid number on the sealed envelope and then placed inside the delivery envelope to be mailed. Proposals must be filled out in ink or type-written. No alterations or interlineations will be permitted, unless made before submission, initialed, and dated. At 3:00 p.m. Pacific Time, a public bid opening will take place in the Boardroom at the District's Main office at 104 Hooker Road, Sequim WA. The District reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive technicalities or irregularities and to accept any bid if such action is believed to be for the best interest of the District.

The Project will consist of water main upgrades to the Clallam Bay and Sekiu water system, including replacement of approximately 12,500 linear feet of water main and associated water services and restoration of disturbed areas. New water main is required to be installed via open trench construction, pipe bursting, and horizontal directional drilling. The engineer's estimate for the project is \$4,215,000. The entire project, including cleanup, shall be physically completed within 300 working days. The contractor must be licensed, bonded, and insured in the State of Washington. All work performed on this project will be subject to state prevailing wage rates. This project is funded through the Washington State Public Works Board (PWB) Loan program; PWB requirements and provisions must be met by general contractors and all subcontractors. **A pre-bid meeting will be held on Thursday, June 9, 2022 at 12:30 p.m. Pacific Time, at the Sekiu office, located at 15 Sekiu Airport Road, Sekiu, WA 98381. It is highly encouraged, but not mandatory that bidders attend.**

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or proposal bond (surety bond) in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter such Contract and furnish satisfactory Contract Bond within the time stated in the Bid Documents, the bid deposit shall be forfeited to PUD No. 1 of Clallam County.

PUD No. 1 of Clallam County is an Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Employer. Disadvantaged, Minority, and Women's Business Enterprises are encouraged to respond.
