# AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES #030910

THIS AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES (the "Agreement") is made effective as of September 1, 2003, and is between NORTHWEST OPEN ACCESS NETWORK, a Washington nonprofit mutual corporation ("NoaNet"), and PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF CLALLAM COUNTY, a Washington municipal corporation ("District").

In consideration of the mutual covenants herein, the parties agree as follows:

#### 1. NoaNet's Responsibilities

In exchange for the covenants of the District, and subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, NoaNet shall:

- a) Provide a training program for a minimum of two (2) support personnel designated by the District, not to exceed three (3) training sessions per calendar year (one each calendar trimester January-April, May-August, September-December) unless the District's requirements dictate otherwise. Each of these system and equipment training sessions should only have duration of one working day, unless special circumstances dictate additional time. Any additional training sessions during a calendar year (more than three) shall be conducted at the District's expense, charged at the then current labor rates for the NoaNet technical training team.
- b) Supply the District with an on-line maintenance service-based contact and instructional management system, consisting of primary telephone numbers, secondary telephone numbers, site locations, scope of work, checklists, and all contact information for any call out services and procedures.
- c) Provide standard network design, inventory and configuration documentation as needed for the District to supply maintenance of NoaNet sites as identified in Appendix B.
- d) Compensate the District based on a cost-based rate schedule provided by the District and listed in Appendix C, as provided in Paragraph 3.
- e) Be responsible for acquiring, maintaining all spare parts for operation of NoaNet equipment, including stocking, replacement and dispatch.
- f) Schedule outages, upgrades, testing, service ,repair and maintenance with the District's primary support representative.
- g) Provide recommended emergency portable power generation restoration plan and network preventive maintenance procedures and documentation to be used to support Appendix A.
- h) Enter into agreements with other Districts that are members of NoaNet, similar to this Agreement, providing for primary and secondary coverage of NoaNet Points of Presence.

## 2. The District's Responsibilities

In exchange for the covenants of NoaNet, and subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the District shall:

- a) Provide operations and maintenance support as listed in Appendix A.
- b) Provide support to NoaNet Points of Presence in primary and secondary roles as listed in Appendix B. Primary support is defined as first point of contact for emergency call out response, and responsibility for routine preventative maintenance and portable power generation. Secondary support is defined as second point of contact for emergency call out response and supplements the primary support as needed. Primary and secondary support for routine and preventative maintenance is subject to the District's priorities being met first.
- c) Provide local support to be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year (24x7x365). Local support is generally defined as technical resources available to respond to NoaNet's Network Operations Center (NOC) service requests. Call-out support and portable power generation support will include three (3) hour on-site response time for locations within 45 miles of any assigned District resource, and four (4) hour on-site response time for all others. Local support for routine and preventative maintenance provided to NoaNet by the District shall be subject to the District's own support and call-out priorities being met first as determined by the District.
- d) Maintain a logbook tracking local and material expenses for call out services, routine maintenance, and service provisioning as listed in Appendix C, and supply NoaNet an itemized summary of tracked expenses, as provided in Paragraph 3.
- e) Designate a local support representative to act as Program Manager. Program Manager will act as primary contact for operations and maintenance support as listed in Appendix A.
- f) Provide a minimum of two (2) trained support personnel to provide maintenance services. The District shall supply to NoaNet emergency dispatch telephone numbers/pager numbers and business hours contact information. The District shall supply to NoaNet a level one contact number and escalation numbers.
- g) Brief NoaNet Operations Manager or designee about all routine and emergency maintenance actions performed on NoaNet points of presence.
- h) Comply with maintenance procedures and practices as listed on the NoaNet online support services system, as updated by NoaNet from time to time.
- i) Provide to NoaNet dispatch implementation plan and detailed specifications of portable generation to be used to support Appendix A to include power (kw), voltage, run capacity, and refueling plan. Emergency portable power generation provided to NoaNet by the District shall be subject to the District's own back-up generation as determined by the District.

#### 3. Invoices and Payment

- (a) The District shall supply to NoaNet an itemized invoice of expenses incurred each calendar quarter by the District in providing the services required of it under this Agreement. Such invoice will be directed to the attention of the "NoaNet Operations Manager." Subject to payment deferral as set forth in paragraph (b) below, NoaNet shall remit payment on the invoice no later than fifteen (15) days after receipt of the invoice.
- (b) For the first year (365 days) after the date of this Agreement beginning on the date of this Agreement, the charges assessed to NoaNet shall be deferred for one year without interest. During that year, invoices will be issued pursuant to paragraph (a). NoaNet shall make a lump sum payment for the total charges invoiced during such year on or before the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) day after the end of such year. During the first year, the District may not effect any payment by means of set off or similar remedy. NoaNet agrees to reimburse the District in full for all costs associated with work completed from May 1, 2001 to the termination of this Agreement.

#### 4. Termination

This Agreement may be terminated at any time, as follows:

- (a) By either party, upon giving the other sixty (60) days' written notice.
- (b) By either party, upon a material breach of this Agreement, effective immediately upon written notice thereof by the terminating party to the other party, unless the breach is one capable of cure within thirty (30) days, in which event the termination will be effective only after the aggrieved party has given notice to the breaching party and the breaching party has failed to promptly commence a reasonable cure and diligently pursued it to completion within thirty (30) days after the notice was effective. Obligations incurred before termination shall remain in full force and effect until fully performed.

#### 5. Taxes

Each party shall be responsible for its own federal, state and local taxes, assessments and other financial impositions. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the District agrees that if there is any tax payable by it, but which is to be collected by NoaNet which NoaNet does not collect for any reason, upon assessment thereof by the applicable taxing agency (together with any interest or penalties thereon), and demand by NoaNet, the District shall immediately remit the same to NoaNet or the agency, as directed by NoaNet, even if such assessment arises after the termination of this Agreement.

#### 6. Standard of Services

The District warrants that the services to be performed by it under this Agreement will be performed in a professional manner by qualified and properly trained personnel and accordance with the performance levels, applicable specifications and documentation set forth or incorporated by reference in the Appendices attached hereto.

## 7. Limitation of Liability; Indemnity

- (a) To the fullest extent permitted by law (including without limitation the provisions of RCW 4.24.115), the District shall not be liable to NoaNet, its officers, directors, agents, principals, or employees (or to any person claiming rights deriving from NoaNet's rights) for any indirect, special, punitive or consequential damages, loss of profits or revenues, or exemplary damages of any kind or nature whatsoever (including but not limited to, any claim from any client or customer for loss of services), whether arising out of this Agreement or from any breach or partial breach of the provisions of this Agreement, or arising out of any act or omission of the District, its employees, officers, subcontractors, agents, affiliates, successors or assigns, or arising under theories of strict liability or tort. This limitation of liability exists regardless of whether any such party was advised, had other reason to know, or in fact knew of the possibility thereof.
- (b) To the fullest extent permitted by law (including without limitation the provisions of RCW 4.24.115), NoaNet agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the District, its Commissioners, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and subcontractors from and against all suits, actions, proceedings, claims, demands judgments, damages, and expenses arising out of this Agreement or the performance of the parties' obligations hereunder. If a claim or demand is asserted against a party in respect of which such party may be entitled to indemnification under this Agreement, written notice of such claim or demand shall promptly be given by such party to NoaNet, which notice shall include a description of the facts within the indemnified party's knowledge that relate to such claim or demand. NoaNet shall assume the entire control of the defense, compromise, or settlement of the matter, including employment of counsel of NoaNet's choice. Any settlement or compromise of an indemnified matter by NoaNet shall include a full release of claims against the indemnified party that have arisen out of the indemnified claim or demand. NoaNet shall be fully released from its obligation to provide defense, indemnification and hold harmless hereunder if the indemnified party fails to fully cooperate with it in the conduct of such matter and all legal proceedings relating thereto.

## 8. Relationship of the Parties

In performing this Agreement, the District is acting as an independent contractor and not as an employee or agent of NoaNet. There is no relationship of agency, partnership, joint venture, employment or franchise between the parties. Each party agrees that it has no authority hereunder to assume or create any obligation or responsibility, expressed or implied, on behalf of or in the name of the other party. Staff of each party performing the services required of it under this Agreement shall at all times remain under the direction and control of said party. Each party reserves its right to replace any of its employees with another of like qualifications and experience. Reasonable notice will be given when such replacement is required and the parties shall endeavor to maintain continuity of effort. For purposes of this Agreement, the District shall be permitted to subcontract portions of services to be performed hereunder to third parties.

#### 9. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable under this Agreement for, or be considered to be in material breach or default under this Agreement on account of, any delay in or failure of performance due

to force majeure unless specifically stated in this Agreement. "Force Majeure" means acts of God (including but not limited to, earthquakes, fires, floods, windstorms, landslides, and icestorms); strikes, lockouts, or other labor disputes; acts of public enemy; acts of vandalism, wars, riots, and insurrection; epidemics; civic disturbances; explosions; train derailments; breakdown or failure of machinery or facilities; accidents to machinery or equipment, and delay in delivery of equipment, to the extent such occurrences are beyond the reasonable control of a party; electrical disturbance originating in or transmitted through a party's electrical system or equipment or any electrical system with which such party's system or equipment is interconnected; and any other event, cause, or condition beyond a party's reasonable control which, by the exercise of reasonable diligence, prevents the party claiming force majeure from performing its obligations under this Agreement.

## 10. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute that arises out of the interpretation, performance, enforcement, or any other aspect of this Agreement, shall be resolved by submitting the same to binding arbitration which shall proceed according to the Superior Court Mandatory Arbitration Rules (MAR) for a case assigned for arbitration in Clallam County; provided that each party shall select a nominating person within ten (10) days of notice of the dispute from any party to the others. The two nominating persons shall then meet and promptly select the arbitrator. If the nominating persons do not select a person who agrees to serve as arbitrator within thirty (30) days of the first notice, the arbitrator shall be selected by a Superior Court Judge of Clallam County. The arbitrator's fees shall be paid by the party that the arbitrator determines was the unsuccessful party.

#### 11. Notices

All notices, requests, demands or other communications which are required or may be given pursuant to the terms of this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been given (i) on the date of delivery if personally delivered by hand, (ii) upon the third day after such notice is (a) deposited in the United States mail, if mailed by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, or (b) sent by a nationally recognized overnight express courier, or (iii) by facsimile upon written confirmation (other than the automatic confirmation that is received from the recipient's facsimile machine) or receipt by the recipient of such notice:

Such addresses and facsimile numbers may be changed, from time to time, by means of a notice given in the manner provided in this Paragraph 11.

#### 12. Audit

Each party and its auditors may conduct periodic audits of the other party's operations pursuant to this Agreement to verify that it is performing in accordance with the provisions hereof and that its invoices conform to the provisions of this Agreement. The auditing party will bear the cost of any such audit unless the audit discloses fraud or willful misconduct by the other party, in which event the other party shall reimburse the auditing party in full for the cost of such audit.

#### 13. Miscellaneous Provisions

#### 13.1 Law

This Agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.

#### 13.2 Entire Agreement

This Agreement (and any attached Appendices) contains the entire agreement and understanding of the parties with respect to the entire subject matter hereof, and there are no representations, inducements, promises or agreements, oral or otherwise, not embodied herein. Any and all prior discussions, negotiations, commitments and understandings relating to the subject matters hereof are merged herein.

#### 13.3 Amendment and/or Modification

Neither this Agreement nor any term or provision hereof, may be changed, waived, discharged, amended, modified or terminated orally, or in any manner other than by an instrument in writing signed by authorized representatives of the parties.

#### 13.4 Assignment

Subject to the ability of the District to subcontract portions of the services to be performed hereunder, as provided in Paragraph 8, the parties agree that this Agreement may not be transferred or assigned by either party to any other person.

## 13.5 Rights of Parties

Nothing in this Agreement, whether express or implied is intended to confer any rights or remedies under or by reason of this Agreement on any persons other than the parties to it and their respective successors and assigns, nor is anything in this Agreement intended to relieve or discharge the obligation or liability of any third persons to any party to the Agreement, nor shall any provision give any third persons any right of subrogation or action over against any party to this Agreement.

#### 13.6 Waiver

The consent by a party to any act by the other party shall not be deemed to imply consent or to constitute the waiver of a breach of any provision hereof or continuing waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or any other provision, nor shall any custom or practice which may arise between the parties or in the administration of any part of the provisions hereof be construed to waive or lessen the right of a party to insist upon the performance by the other party in strict accordance with the provisions hereof.

#### Appendix A

**Scope of Service** — The agreement will have three distinct areas, each with responsibilities as indicated below.

- 1. <u>Preventative Maintenance</u>: the district will provide the following preventative maintenance services at each location once a month:
  - Battery Maintenance
    - o Charge check
    - o Container check
    - o Fail-over test quarterly
  - Equipment Check and Cleaning
    - o Check cables for neatness and orderliness, adjust appropriately
    - o Check equipment area for neatness and tidiness, adjust appropriately
    - o Check dirt and dust build-up on equipment, clean as appropriate
  - Preventative Checks
    - o Check facility integrity
    - o Verify site documentation
    - o Inspect and clean filter assemblies
    - o Verify equipment is properly secured
    - o Verify fans are operating and unobstructed
    - Weed Control
  - Security Checks
    - o Check facility security
    - o Verify security equipment operation
  - Generator Maintenance (where applicable)
    - Function Check
    - o Fuel Check
- 2. <u>Call-Out Services</u>: the district will provide 24x7x365 "Dispatch Service" in response to a NoaNet or NoaNet NOC trouble call:
  - Maintenance
    - Replace cables
    - o Replace modules
    - o Replace equipment
    - o OTDR fiber testing assistance
    - Work with NOC personnel to test repair work
- 3. <u>Portable Power Generation</u>: the district will provide 24x7x365 "Dispatch Service" in response to a NoaNet or NoaNet NOC trouble call where a site has lost commercial power without predicted resolution:
  - Mobilize Generation to Specific Site
    - o Connect Portable Generation to NoaNet Shelter

- o Maintain Portable Generation Until Commercial Power is Confirmed Stable by Serving Utility
- o Check AC breaker box for tripped breakers and reset those breakers that have been tripped.
- o De-Mobilize
- Generation Requirements
  - o Receptacle Specification; Appleton AJA20033RS.
  - o Power; 240/120 VAC single phase.
  - o Size; 5-10 KW Generator
