The District will notify the lowest bidder no later than May 4, 2023, 3:00 Pacific Time to demonstrate experience, aircraft registration, pilot FAA certification or endorsement to perform external load operations, and a record of safe practices and procedures, due no later than May 10, 2023, 2:30 p.m. Pacific Time.

The Contractor acknowledges having made a careful examination of the Project and of the exhibits, maps, and available shape files and has become informed as to the location and nature of the proposed service, kind, and character of soil, terrain, and vegetation to be encountered; the kind of equipment, tools, and other facilities required before and during the Project; and has

become acquainted with the labor conditions which would affect work on the Project.

4. The Contractor warrants possession of adequate financial resources for the performance of the work covered by this Proposal and that the firm will provide necessary tools, materials, and equipment and a qualified pilot(s), aircraft(s), supporting air and ground control employees, mechanics, safety, technical, and other supporting employees.

5. Contractor Information Compliance and Regulations:

The Contractor, and all workers and equipment engaged in work on the Project, shall comply with all applicable statutes, ordinances, rules, and regulations pertaining to the work, including, without limitation, the rules and regulations set forth by the Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act of 1973, the Williams-Steiger Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, and 29 CFR 1910.269 (concerning the operation and maintenance of electric power generation, control, transformation, transmission and distribution lines and equipment).

All traffic control shall comply with all regulations and requirements of the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
